

JUAN CARLOS RIESCO NAMED PARTNER IN CAREY

Carey has appointed Juan Carlos Riesco as a new partner to lead the litigation and arbitration practice along with partners Gonzalo Fernández, Ricardo Reveco and Aldo Molinari. Carey now has 32 partners, six counsels, two directors of tax and audit and more than 250 associates. In 2014, after completing his LL.M., Juan Carlos worked as foreign associate in the International Arbitration group at Arnold & Porter LLP in Washington, DC. Currently, he is a member of the panel of young arbitrators of the Arbitration and Mediation Center of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce and a member of the Chilean Bar Association.
