

MASISA OBTAINS A US\$100 MILLION CREDIT LOAN FROM RABOBANK AND OTHER BANKS

Two separate teams from Chilean firm Carey have advised Chilean wood products company Masisa and a group of lending banks on a US\$100 million credit facility granted to the manufacturer.
