MASISA SELLS THE INDUSTRIAL BUSINESS OF ITS ARGENTINEAN SUBSIDIARY

Argentina's Estudio Beccar Varela has helped Austrian wood panels company Egger acquire assets from counterpart company Masisa.

Masisa, which is headquartered in Chile, hired Allende & Breain Buenos Aires and Carey in Santiago to sell its Argentine subsidiary for US\$155million. The sale was agreed on 17 July.

The transaction is subject to regulatory approval in Argentina and is expected to close within three months.
